

Borrowing the Blue Heron Kiln

Here are the steps to take:

1. Attend a biochar workshop to get hands-on experience and knowledge about using the kiln.
2. Send a request email to info@blueheronlearning.ca.
3. We will send you approval for a date and the Biochar 101 Guide containing instructions for using the kiln, a waiver for you to sign, and the pick-up location and time.
4. You e-transfer the \$10 donation for borrowing the kiln to info@blueheronlearning.ca.
5. Book your permit with the GVFD.
6. Check air quality on day of pick-up (day before the burn) and proceed if air quality is in the right range.
7. Pick up the kiln and safety instructions from Blue Heron (110 McConvey Road) on the date and time agreed and bring your signed waiver.
8. Have fun making biochar!!
9. Bring back the kiln at the agreed upon time (send an email to info@blueheronlearning.ca to confirm what time you will be dropping it off to ensure someone is there to help).
